Know all Men by these Presents: That I Edward Dean of Eureka State of Nevada the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500⁰⁰) dollars, Gold Coin of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by Siebe Brothers and Plageman of San Francisco California the parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part, their executors, administrators and assigns.

All of the following described personal property now situate and being in that certain Saloon formerly occupied by me situate on the East side of Main Street in said Town of Eureka to wit: All of the personal property in the saloon above named consisting of one Bar, Looking Glass, Lamps, Chairs Glasses Tables and Liquors of Various kinds and qualities the same being all of the liquors of every kind now in said Saloon, together with all and every kind of personal property now in said Saloon belonging to me or in my possession.

I have and to hold the same to the said parties of the second part, their executors, administrators and assigns forever. And I do for myself heirs, executors and administrators covenant and agree to and with the said parties of the second part, their executors, administrators and assigns, to warrant and defend the sale of the said property, goods and chattels hereby made unto the said parties of the second part, their executors, administrators and assigns, against all and every person and persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
