

Know all Men by these Presents: That I Adolph Paguim of the Town and County of Churchill State of Nevada party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred + fifty (\$950 ^{100/100}) Dollars to me in hand paid by Luis Cantier of the same place County and State party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do as granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do I grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns all my ^{and} titles interest on my two horses - one of them being gray Colfax and the other buckskin Colfax also all the harness appurtenant to said horses and one front Large whagon with all the fixtures thereon.

I do have and to hold the same to said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns forever. And I do for his heirs, executors and administrators covenant and agree to and with the

said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the sale of said property, goods and chattels hereby made unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, against all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
