Whilton agrees to accept at the expiration of six months from this date, any sum not less than five hundred and exceeding one thousand Dollars, upon the note and Mortgage this day executed by J. O. Swenson & Johanna Swenson to said J. S. Whilton for the sum of two thousand Dollars due one year after date.
