# Bill of Sale

Know all Men by these Presents: That We  
to Malatesta and William Liggett of the  
Town and County of Custer and State of  
Nevada the parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the  
sum of Four Hundred and Fifty (\$450-) Dollars dollars Gold  
bills of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by  
W. O. Mills Jr. of the same place the party of the second part, the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,  
sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell,  
and convey unto the said party of the second part, his executors, ad-  
ministrators and assigns.

All of that certain building and saloon situated  
on the Northwest corner of Clark and Buel Streets in said town  
and now in our possession and belonging to us and generally  
known and called the "Narrow Gage Saloon"

To Have And To Hold the same to the said party  
of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns for-  
ever. And we do for ourselves and our heirs, executors and admin-  
istrators covenant and agree to and with the said party of the  
second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, to warrant  
and defend the sale of the said property, goods and chattels hereby  
made unto the said party of the second part, his executors, ad-  
ministrators and assigns, against all and every person and persons  
whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
