This Indenture, made and entered into at Custer

State of Nevada, this 23rd day of September A.D.

One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy Nine

Between J. S. Whilton of Custer County State of

Nevada the party of the first part and James J. Mason of said County
 and State the party of the second part, witnesseth, That the said party
 of the first part, has letten, and by these presents does grant, demise,
 and let unto the said party of the second part, and the said party
 of the second part has hired and taken, and by these presents
 does hire and take of and from the said party of the first part
 the following described premises situated in the town and County
 of Custer State of Nevada and bounded and particularly de-
 scribed as follows to wit: A portion of Lot number eleven in Block
 Number five of the Monroe Survey of the town of Custer County of
 Custer State of Nevada, the portion of said lot hereby demised.
 being twenty four feet wide by forty feet long upon the west end of
 said, and fronting twenty four feet wide upon Main Street, in
 said town and extending easterly the same uniform width a
 distance of Forty feet, with the appurtenances for the space of two
 years and eight months from the first day of October A.D. One
 Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy Nine at the monthly
 rent or sum of One hundred (\$100) Dollars, payable monthly
 in advance in equal payments of One hundred Dollars in Gold
 Coin of the United States, of the Standard of A.D. 1861.

Provided that if during the pendency of this lease the said
 party of the first part should sell or dispose of said demised premises in
 that case the said second party is to surrender the possession of
 said premises upon 15 days notice in writing, at any time after
 the expiration of two years. And it is agreed, That if any rent
 shall be due and unpaid, or if default shall be made in any of the
 covenants herein contained, then it shall be lawful for the said
 party of the first part to re-enter the said premises, and to remove
 all persons therefrom.

And the said party of the second part does hereby
 covenant to pay the said party of the first part the said monthly
 rent, herein reserved in the manner herein specified. And not to
 let or underlet the whole or any part of said premises, or make or
 suffer any alterations to be made therein, without the written con-
 sent of the said party of the first part; and not to assign this lease
 without the written consent of the said party of the first part.

And that at the expiration of said term, or any sooner deter-
 mination of this lease, the said party of the second part will quit and
 surrender the premises hereby demised, in as good order and con-
 dition as reasonable use and wear thereof will permit, damages by
 the elements excepted. And if the party of the second part shall hold
 over the said term with the consent, expressed or implied, of the party
 of the first part, such holding shall be construed to be a tenancy
 only from month to month.
