Bond for Deed.

Know all Men by these Presents: That we William Arington and M. P. Bartlett of the Town and County of Eureka, in the State of Nevada, are held and firmly bound unto W. A. Malcolm of the City of London, England in the sum of Two hundred thousand dollars, in gold coin of the United States of America to be paid to the said W. A. Malcolm, his executors, administrators or assigns; for which payment, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated the eighth day of December A. D. 1879. The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden obligors shall on or before the first day of February A. D. 1880, make, execute and deliver to the said W. A. Malcolm (provided the said Malcolm shall owe or before that day have paid to the said obligors the sum of One hundred Thousand Dollars in Gold coin of the United States of America, the price agreed to be paid by the said Malcolm) a good and sufficient deed of all that Real Estate property and premises described as

follows, viz: First. That certain mining ground and those mines,
 mining claims and locations, bodies or deposits, situate, lying and being in
 the Secret-Canyon Mining District, in the said County of Eureka and
 State of Nevada, and known and described as follows, to wit: 1st.
 That certain mine located, owned and held by and in the name of the
 "Geddes No. 3," by Samuel Geddes, Louis Bertrand and W.H. Carter on the
 19th day of August A.D. 1869, and duly recorded in the Records of Eureka
 Mining District in Eureka (then Lander) County Nevada and containing
 Eight-Hundred (800) feet. 2nd. That certain mine located, owned and
 held by and in the name of the "Geddes No. 4," by the parties last afore-
 said on the same day and recorded in the Book of Records of the same
 Mining District and also containing Eight-Hundred (800) feet. 3rd.
 That certain mine located, owned and held by and in the name of
 the "Bertrand No. 2," by the same parties on the same day and also
 recorded in the Records of Eureka Mining District, and containing
 Eight-Hundred (800) feet. 4th. That certain mine located, owned and
 held by and in the name of the "Geddes No. 2," on the 23rd day of
 August A.D. 1869, by the parties last aforesaid and recorded in the Rec-
 cords of said Eureka Mining District, containing Eight-Hundred (800)
 feet. 5th. That certain mine located and held by and in the
 name of the "Bertrand No. 4," in the Mining District last aforesaid
 on the 25th day of August A.D. 1869, and containing Eight-Hundred
 (800) feet. 6th. That certain mine located, owned and held by and
 in the name of the "Bertrand No. 1," by the same parties on the same
 day, and recorded in the Records of the same Mining District and
 containing Eight-Hundred (800) feet. 7th. That certain mine located,
 owned and held by and in the name of the "Bertrand No. 3," on or
 about the 23rd day of August A.D. 1869, by the said Samuel Geddes,
 Louis Bertrand and W.H. Carter, which said mine is commonly called
 the "Calico Mine" and upon which is the shaft known as the "Calico
 Shaft" and upon which is situated the hoisting Works of the said
 obligors herein. 8th. That certain mine located, owned and held by
 and in the name of the "Stockton" or "Stocklow No. 1," at the 23rd day
 of August A.D. 1869, by William Crides, W.H. Carter and George
 Oberhardt and Samuel Geddes, and duly recorded in the Records
 of Eureka Mining District, containing One Thousand (1000) feet.
9th. That certain mining claim located, owned and held by and
 in the name of the "Stockton No. 2," on the same day and by the
 same parties as named in the "Stockton No. 1," containing one
 thousand (1000) feet. 10th. That certain mine located, owned and
 held by and in the name of the "Secret Valley" on the 2nd day of
 September A.D. 1869, and in the names of Louis Bertrand, Samuel
 Geddes and W.H. Carter, and recorded in the Records of Eureka
 Mining District, and containing Eight-Hundred (800) feet.
 All of which said mines were recorded in the Records of Eureka
 Mining District before the said Secret-Canyon Mining District
 was organized and set-off from said Eureka Mining District.
11th. That certain mine located, owned and held by and in the
 name of the "Osborne and Elzy" on the 9th day of October A.D.
 1873, by J.P. Osborne, E.J. Elzy and G.J. Gardner and duly record-
 ed in the Records of the Secret-Canyon Mining District, in said
 County of Eureka and containing Six-Hundred (600) feet;
 together with all the dips, spurs and angles, and also all the

metals, ores, gold and silver bearing quartz, rock and earth contained and being in or upon said mines, mining claims or locations and each and every of them. Second. That certain private wagon road of the said obligors herein, leading from the said mines or a part of them to the mouth of Cave Canyon in said Secret Lander Mining District. Third. All those certain pieces of parcels or tracts of land or ranches, situate, lying and being in the said County of Eureka and State of Nevada, and bounded and described as follows, to wit: 1st. That certain tract of land or parcel thereof, beginning at a Mahogany tree marked "1" about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile west of the line between Eureka (formerly Lander) and White Pine Counties, State of Nevada, and in Secret Valley in said Eureka County about 600 feet north of the house formerly occupied by Samuel Geddes, and running thence 1. 880 chains to a Mahogany tree marked "2", thence 2. W 20 chains to a Mahogany tree marked "3", thence 3. N 80 chains to a Mahogany tree marked "4", thence 4. E 20 chains to place of beginning, containing 160 acres, surveyed by true meridian, variation 16 deg. East and located, surveyed and recorded for Samuel Geddes. 2nd. That certain piece or tract of land beginning at the S.E. corner of land surveyed for Samuel Geddes as aforesaid, and running thence 1. E. 20 chains to a pine tree marked "2", thence 2. N. 80 chains to a stake marked "3", thence 3. W 20 chains to a Mahogany tree marked "4", thence 4. S 80 chains to place of beginning, containing 160 acres, surveyed by true meridian, variation 16 deg. E. and located, surveyed and recorded for Louis Bertrand. 3rd. That certain piece or parcel of land beginning at the S.E. corner of land surveyed for Samuel Geddes, at point marked "2" and running thence 1. E. 20 chains to a pine tree marked "3", thence 2. S. 80 chains to a pine tree marked "4", thence 3. W. 40 chains, to a Mahogany tree marked "5", thence 4. N. 40 chains to a Mahogany tree marked "6", thence 5. E. 20 chains to the place of beginning, containing 160 acres, surveyed by true meridian, variation 16 deg. E. and located, surveyed and recorded for W. H. Carter. 4th. That certain piece or tract of land, beginning at a Mahogany tree marked "7" at the N.W. corner of land surveyed for Samuel Geddes, and running thence 1. N. 20 chains to a stake marked "8", thence 2. W 20 chains to a stake marked "9", thence 3. S. 80 chains to a Mahogany tree marked "10", thence 4. E. 20 chains to a stake marked "11", thence 5. N. 60 chains to place of beginning, containing 160 acres, surveyed by true meridian, variation 16 deg. E. and located, surveyed and recorded for William Gidder. As also all Springs, water rights and water privileges, franchises and appurtenances of whatever kind or nature sever, to, of, or in, any way belonging to said mines or mining locations, and to said tracts of land or to or of said obligors herein, and heretofore belonging to the Geddes and Bertrand Mill and Mining Company and conveyed by the Sheriff of said Eureka County to the said obligors herein, by deed dated November 5th A.D. 1877, and recorded in the Records of said Eureka County, November 5th A.D. 1877, in Liber 5 of Deeds, Pages 519 to 523 inclusive; together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining. Then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. And it is distinctly understood that time shall be considered

as of the essence of his obligations.
