Lease

This Indenture, made and entered into at Eureka  
State of Nevada, this 28<sup>th</sup> day of October A. D. One  
Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy Nine Between  
Charles Lautenschlager of the Township County of  
Eureka State aforesaid party of the first part and Pramenko and Ballich  
of the same place the parties of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said  
party of the first part, has letting, and by these presents does grant, demise,  
and let unto the said parties of the second part, and the said parties of  
the second part have hired and taken, and by these presents do hire and  
take of and from the said party of the first part Those certain premises  
situated on the South West corner of Clark and Quel Streets in said Town  
and now used by the parties of the second part as a Restaurant and being  
the Eastern portion of the stone building now occupied by the party of the  
first part as a Saloon, with the appurtenances for the period of two (2)  
years from the First (1<sup>st</sup>) day of October A. D. One Thousand Eight Hun-  
dred and Seventy Nine at the monthly rent or sum of One Hundred (\$100.)  
Dollars, payable monthly in advance, in equal payments of One Hundred  
(\$100.) Dollars in Gold Coin of the United States. And it is Agreed, That  
if any rent shall be due and unpaid, or if default shall be made in any  
of the covenants herein contained, then it shall be lawful for the said party  
of the first part to re-enter the said premises, and to remove all persons therefrom.  
And the said parties of the second part do hereby covenant to pay the  
said party of the first part the said \$100.-rent, herein reserved in the  
manner herein specified. And not to let or underlet the whole or any part  
of said premises, or make or suffer any alterations to be made therein, with-  
out the written consent of the said party of the first part; and not to  
assign this Lease without the written consent of the said party of the first  
part. And that at the expiration of said term, or any sooner determination  
of this Lease, the said parties of the second part will quit and surrender the  
premises hereby demised, in as good order and condition as reasonable use  
and wearthereof will permit, damages by the elements excepted. And if  
the parties of the second part shall hold over the said term with the con-  
sent, express or implied, of the party of the first part, such holding shall  
be construed to be a tenancy only from month to month.
