And now on this 22nd day of January A.D. 1880, comes Plaintiff

and has filed his complaint, wherein he alleges that the defendant above named is indebted to him the said plaintiff in the sum of \$61, ⁶⁴/₁₀₀ on account of board. Plaintiff also had filed his Affidavit for attachment and an approved undertaking on attachment in the sum of \$200 ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Gold coin, with Joseph Mendes and Charles Cutlar as sureties. And thereupon the court issued summons and writ of attachment and placed them in the hands of Constable F. O. Gorman for service. Said summons is made returnable at one o'clock P. M. on the 26th day of January A. D. 1880. And now on this 26th day of January A. D. 1880, the parties appear and Defendant admits in open court that Plaintiffs demand is just, and that ^{he} the said Defendant is indebted to Plaintiff in the amount by him claimed. And thereupon Plaintiff moved the court for judgment for the amount of his demand and costs, and the court sustained the motion. Wherefore it is ordered and adjudged that the said Plaintiff do have and recover of and from the said defendant the sum of Sixty one & ⁶⁴/₁₀₀ dollars and costs of suit taxed at \$24 ⁷⁵/₁₀₀ and have this his judgement therefor and the whole thereof.
