### Lease.

This Indenture made the Thirty first day of January  
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and eighty, Between Eureka Lodge No. 22 of the  
Independent Order of Odd Fellows of Nevada, at Eureka,  
Eureka County in said State, by and through its Trust-  
ees Charles L. Troy, Benjamin C. Levy and Morris Calisher all of the same  
place, therunto duly authorized by the said Eureka Lodge No. 22 I.O.O.F.  
aforesaid, by resolution dated December 4th 1879, to wit: "The trustees are  
authorized to consult and make arrangements with the Trustees of other or-  
ganizations for the purpose of securing the tenancy of the new hall in the Foley  
and Rickard Building," the party of the first part, and Alpha Lodge  
No. 1. of the Ancient Order of United Workmen, at Eureka aforesaid, by  
and through its Trustees A. E. Shannon, H. T. Broadley and G. A. Fletcher  
thereto duly authorized by the said Alpha Lodge No. 1. A. O. U. W. by re-  
solution dated December 23rd A.D. 1879, to wit: "The offer of the Trustees  
of Eureka Lodge No. 22 I. O. O. F. of Nevada, to let the new hall to Alpha  
Lodge No. 1. A. O. U. W. for one year at \$35<sup>00</sup> per month on Tuesday evenings,  
with the privilege of two years thereafter on the same terms was upon motion  
accepted," the party of the second part, Witnesseth, that the said party of the  
first part, has let and by these presents does grant, demise and let unto  
the said party of the second part, all of the following described premises, to  
wit: Those four certain rooms in the new brick building now being in the  
course of completion, in the town of Eureka, Nevada, and owned by M. D. Foley  
and R. Rickard and by them let and devised unto the said party of  
the first part and described in a lease bearing date December 20th 1879,  
and duly recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Eureka County,  
Nevada, in Fibco "A" of "Miscellaneous" on pages 681, 682 & 683; on each and  
every Tuesday for the term of one year from the tenth day of February A.  
D. 1880, or as soon thereafter as the said premises shall be ready for occu-  
pancy, at the yearly rent of Four Hundred and twenty Dollars in U.S. Gold  
Coin, to be paid in monthly payments of Thirty five Dollars per month in  
advance. And it is agreed that if the said rent, or any part thereof shall  
be due and unpaid, or if default shall be made in any of the covenants  
herein contained, then it shall be lawful for the said party of the first  
part to re-enter the said premises and remove all persons therefrom. And the  
said party of the first part hereby further agrees to furnish the said Hall  
and keep it furnished during the term of this Lease in a comfortable man-  
ner, and to keep the same in good order and furnish all wood and lights  
required. And the said party of the second part doth covenant to pay to  
the said party of the first part the said yearly rent as herein specified  
namely in monthly payments in advance as aforesaid during the said  
term of one year. And that at the expiration of said term, the said party  
of the second part will quit and surrender the premises hereby demised in  
as good state and condition as reasonable use and wear thereof will  
permit, damages by the elements excepted. It is however expressly stipu-  
lated by and between the parties hereto, that in case the said premises  
should be destroyed in whole or in part by fire or the Act of God, then  
and in that event the rent herein specified shall cease until the

premises aforesaid shall become again tenable during the term of this Lease. And the said party of the second part hereby agrees not to let or underlet the said premises or any part thereof without the written consent of the party of the first part. And the said party of the first part does covenant that the said party of the second part, on paying the said yearly rent in the manner aforesaid, shall and may peaceably and quietly have, hold and enjoy the said demised premises for the term aforesaid. And the said party of the first part further covenants and agrees that the said party of the second part shall have the privilege of renewing this lease at the expiration thereof for a further term of two years upon the same terms and conditions as herein specified. And it is further agreed that these presents shall bind the successors and assigns of the respective parties hereto.
