To James M. Collins: You and your representatives,
and successors in interest are hereby notified that we

have performed work and labor on the Daniel O'Connell Mine, situated on the southerly side of Freeman Hill, and near the canyon dividing Ruby Hill from Freeman Hill, in the Eureka Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada, to the amount and value of \$480 in U.S. gold coin, during the past four years to wit: From the month of January 1876, to and including January 1, 1880, the same being \$120 for each year: that your proportion of the cost of said work and labor for the said four years, is \$120. And you and your representatives, and successors, are hereby notified that if you fail to contribute your said proportion of the cost of said labor and work within one hundred and eighty days from the date hereof, your interest in said Daniel O'Connell mine and ledge will become the property of the undersigned, your co-owners in said mine, who have made the said expenditures and performed said work and labor, in accordance and by virtue of the laws of Congress, Section 2, 324 of the Revised Statutes of the United States.
