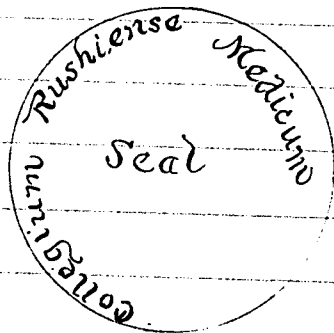
To all to whom these presents shall come,
