This Agreement made and entered into this 5th day
of July 1880 by and between Thomas Mitchell of
Eureka County State of Nevada the party of the
first part. And Alex Frazer A. G. Mc Kenzie and
Joseph Mendes of the same County and State. Wit-
nesseth, That whereas the said Thomas Mitchell


now is the owner of the Right to search for and discover mines and min-
erals also all ledges or deposits of Mineral bearing rock in the province of Nova
Scotia in the Dominion of Canada Kingdom of Great Britain.

Now therefore for the purpose of forming a Partnership with
the said Alex Frazer A. G. Mc Kenzie and Joseph Mendes and the
further consideration of One Dollar lawful money in hand paid the re-
ceipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the first party the said first
party agrees that the above named second parties shall have each an
equal interest with him in the above named right of search for mines
and minerals. And it is further mutually agreed and understood that
in case any of the parties hereto should in the future acquire any other
right to search for minerals or mines in any province in any part of the
British possessions in North America that each party to this Agreement

shall be equally interested therein. That is to say that in the right that Thomas Mitchell owns, as well as any right that may hereafter be acquired. Thomas Mitchell shall own One fourth (1/4) Alex Fraser
^{and Joseph Mendes shall own the other}
^{own} shall own One fourth R. G. M McKenzie shall own one fourth. This Agreement to remain in full force for one year from date hereof.
