

Know all men by these presents: that Mrs. A. Benedict, administratrix of the estate of A. Benedict, deceased, of the town of Eureka, and State of Nevada, is held and firmly bound unto R. H. Eggeston of the same place, in the sum of Six Thousand and two hundred and fifty Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to be paid to the said R. H. Eggeston his executors, administrators or assigns; for which payment well and truly to be made bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators firmly by these presents. Sealed with my seal and dated the 19th day of July A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty. The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden obligor, administratrix as aforesaid for the estate of A. Benedict, deceased and for herself, shall on the 19th day of November A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty, make, execute, and deliver as administratrix as aforesaid and for herself unto the said R. H. Eggeston, or to his assigns, (provided that the said R. H. Eggeston shall on or before that day have paid to the said obligor, the sum of Six Thousand Two hundred and fifty Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, the price by said R. H. Eggeston agreed to be paid therefor,) a good and sufficient Deed for conveying and assuring to the said R. H. Eggeston, free from all incumbrances, all the right, title and interest of the estate of said A. Benedict and of said Mrs. A. Benedict, estate, claim and demand, both in law and equity, as well in possession as in expectancy, of, in or to that certain portion, claim and mining right, title or property on those certain veins or lodes of rock, containing precious metals of gold, silver and other minerals, and situated in the Eureka Mining District, County of Eureka, and State of Nevada, described as follows, to wit: That certain mining claim and lode known as the Bald Eagle Lode and mining claim and bounded as follows, to wit: Commencing at a post marked No. 1, and running thence South $1^{\circ}45'$ East eleven hundred and seventy eight feet to a post marked No. 2. S. E. cor. "Bald Eagle," thence South $88^{\circ}15'$ West 125 feet to corner No. 3. a post marked S. W. cor. "Bald Eagle" thence North $1^{\circ}45'$ West 1178 feet to corner No. 4. a post marked S. W. cor. "Bald Eagle" thence North $88^{\circ}15'$ East 125 feet to the place of beginning. Also the North eleven hundred and seventy eight feet of that certain mining claim known as the White Eagle claim and lode and bounded as follows, to wit, on the West by the Bald Eagle, and on the East by the Eagles' Nest. Also the South Eight hundred and thirty-five feet of that certain mining claim known as the Eagles' Nest mining claim and lode bounded on the West by the White Eagle claim above described running parallel therewith and being two hundred feet in width.
