Location Notes

Notes is hereby given that the undersigned having conspired with the United States and local laws and customs and regulations governing in such cases have this day located fifteen hundred (1500) acres of land in the ledge, lead or deposit of minerals bearing argent and such together with all valuable minerals contained therein together with three hundred (300) feet on each side from a point line thereof as surface ground. Commencing at their corner and monument and running north towards and fifty feet north west and seven hundred and fifty feet south east and described as follows. This monument being placed on the highest point of Ferguson Mountain as a large quartzite dikes. This mine is the north west extension of the Ferguson (or Mayfield) mine and shall be known as the St. Louis Mine. Located this 25th day of October 1891, in Schuader Mining District Humboldt Nevada
