

Boston Mines

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having examined and the requirements of the Mining acts of Congress and the local customs laws and regulations have located 1500 feet of air shaft on this mine base or deposits of minerals having rock and sand together with sulphur on each side from a center line thereof an surface ground. Commencing at this notice and measuring and running 750 feet N.W. and 750 feet S.E. and described as follows: Being situated on the Summit of Ferguses Mt and bounded by the Good Eber mine on the S.W. side for 200 ft.
