

Buena Vista Mine

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having complied with the requirements of the Mining Act of Congress and all the local statutes, laws and regulations has located fifteen hundred linear feet on the ledge, bed or deposit of mineral bearing rock and earth together with three hundred feet on the north east side (except when it may conflict with the lines of prior locations) and two hundred feet on the south west side from a center line thereof as surface ground, commencing at this notice and monument and running four hundred and fifty (450) feet in a north westerly direction and one thousand and fifty (1050) feet in a south easterly direction and described as follows. Being situated and located near the south west end of Ferguson Mountain on the West Slope and Summit of said Mountain. This mine is bounded as follows, on the North east side for 100 feet by the Center Mine and for 600 feet by the Good Sheer Mine and on the south west side for 300 feet by the St. Louis Mine and shall be known as the Buena Vista mine, Located this 24th day of November 1891 in Schrader Mining District Humboldt County Nevada
