

The Ripper Mine

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having compliance with the requirements of the United States and local customs laws and regulations has located fifteen hundred linear feet on the ledge, base or deposit of various bearing rock and earth, together with three hundred feet on the south west side and 300 feet on the north east side (except along the line of the Bureau Vista mine where but one hundred feet is used) is claimed from a surface ground. Commencing at this notice and monument and running five hundred feet South easterly and one thousand feet north westerly and describes as follows, being situated at the South west end of Serqueno Mountain on the large granite dike which traverses the Mountain in a North west and South east direction. This Mine is the North west extension of the St. Louis mine and is bounded on the North east side for 1300 feet by the Bureau Vista Mine and shall be known as the Ripper Mine located this 28th day of November 1891. in Schroder Mining District Bureau County Nevada.
