

Daisy W. Family Mine.

Notice is hereby given that, the undersigned claims fifteen hundred linear measure on this lode or vein of gold and silver bearing quartz, commencing at the notch and monument and running westerly therefrom, along the line of the lode a distance of seven hundred and fifty feet to a monument made of a stake and stone and southerly along the line of said lode a distance of seven hundred and fifty feet to a monument made of a Stake and Stone, with the dip shown and angle of said lode, together with the surface ground on each side of said lode, bounded and described as follows, to wit, commencing at the monument last named and running easterly therefrom at a right angle with the general direction of said lode three hundred feet to a monument made of a Stake and Stone; thence at a right angle northerly fifteen hundred feet to a monument made of a stake and Stone; thence at a right angle westerly six hundred feet to a monument made of a stake and stone, thence at a right angle southerly fifteen hundred feet to a monument made of a Stake and Stone and thence at a right angle southerly three hundred feet to the place of beginning. This claim is located on the bull-dog lode and is bounded on the North by the Southern boundary of the Virginia Colwell mine, and on the south by the northern boundary of the snow brook mine said claim shall be called the Daisy W.
