

In that certain lease of the Oneonton, Cavalier, London Valley, Vico, Glittering Galore and Tom Gilliam Mining Claims, in Mill Canyon, Corliss Mining District, Eureka County, and State of Nevada, Between Charles Allen and Phil Paroni, of the town of Eureka, County and State aforesaid, Lessors, and N. N Hunter, of Juneau, Alaska, Lessee, dated the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February 1905, a.D., the following sentence, to wit; "The said Lessor shall have the privilege of directing said shipments to any Smelter or reduction works where the best terms can be obtained", is hereby corrected to read as follows, to wit; The said lessee shall have <sup>the</sup> privilege of directing said shipments to any Smelter or reduction works where the best terms can be obtained; and the sentence, "to allow the said lessees as royalty, Twenty per cent, (20%) of the gross proceeds of the ores taken from said mines, etc, etc," shall be corrected to read as follows, to wit, to allow the said Lessors as royalty, Twenty per cent (20%) of the gross proceeds of the ores taken from said mines, etc, etc. It is hereby agreed between the parties to the lease aforesaid that these corrections shall become a part of said lease. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals, this 27<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1905 A.D. and to two others of like import - P. Paroni
