This supplement to an agreement made and entered into on the 20th day of February A.D. 1905 by and between Charles Allen and Phil Paroni of Eureka Nevada and H. Hunter of Juneau Alaska.

Witnesseth. That it is mutually understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto that the royalty to be paid under the agreement of Feb. 20th by the lessee is (20%) twenty per cent of the gross value of the ore mined, and that all royalty payments are to apply as purchase money paid under an option of the same date for the purchase of certain mining claims, located in Cortez Mining District, and known as the Oneonta, Cavalier, London, Valley View, Glittering Galore and Tom Gilliam. That the receipts of Frank Curcious of Beowawe Nevada for royalty paid shall be accepted by the bank in which deeds are placed in escrow, as payments of a portion of the purchase price, stipulated in the option of Feb. 20th A.D. 1905. It is further understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto, that said Allen and Paroni shall at once obtain from all parties interested, quit claim deeds to said mining claims, and shall place them, together with deeds from said Allen and Paroni, in Escrow in the Eureka County Bank - with copies of the several agreements, and instructions to deliver the deeds to said Hunter and his assigns, when payments in accordance with the agreement of February twentieth A.D. 1905 shall have been made, through payment of royalty or otherwise. This agreement to be attached to and made a part of the agreements of February 20th A.D. 1905.
