To Martin Mahoney and Dave Morris, Greeting:— Take notice that I command you, Martin Mahoney and Dave Morris, and each of you, and all your servants, counselors, attorneys, solicitors, agents, servants, and employees, and each and everyone of you and all others acting in aid or assistance of you to immediately and absolutely desist and refrain from working, digging, mining, or in any manner disturbing or removing earth, rock or dirt from its natural position or place in and upon that certain mine or mining claim known and called the "St. David" claim, situate, lying and being in the Eureka Mining District, County of Eureka, State of Nevada. You will further take notice that I command you, and each of you, your agents, servants, and employees, and you are hereby so commanded, to immediately and absolutely refrain and desist from performing any manner of work or labor in or upon said
