To All Whom It May Concern:- Notice is hereby given that G. D. Kennedy, a citizen of the United States, under the laws of the United States and the laws of the state of Nevada, and in accordance

with the rules and regulations of miners in this district, has this day located the following described non mineral ground, to be used as a mill site which is for the lode claim owned by him and known as the McCoy mining claim, situated, lying and being in this district, about half a mile North East of this site; This site contains five acres of non mineral surface ground more or less and is described by metes and bounds as follows: - Beginning at the stone monument containing this location notice, whence the highest peak of Roberts Creek mountains bears north 25. degrees west magnetic, a distance of about fourteen miles, and the station house on the E. & P. railroad at Mineral Station bears north 10. degrees west magnetic, a distance of about five miles, and running thence six hundred feet northerly along the west line of the Tyler Claim and the Water Pipe claim, to a monument marked "corner No. 1." of the "Mineral Hill Mill Site", thence at right angles in a westerly direction for a distance of 365. feet to a stone monument marked "corner No. 2." "Mineral Hill Mill Site" thence at right angles in a southerly direction for a distance of 600. feet to a stone monument marked "Corner No. 3" "Mineral Hill Mill Site", thence at right angles in an Easterly direction for a distance of 365. feet to the place of beginning; to wit; Corner No. 1. This mill site is situated in the Mineral Hill Mining District Eureka County Nevada and is known as the "Mineral Hill Mining Claim site" and I intend to use this site for all purposes of a mill site for the McCoy Mining Claim.
