Snyder, of the town of Ruby Hill, said County and State, the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators or assigns, all their right, title and interest in and to that certain personal property described as follows, to-wit: - The dwelling house situate on Ruby Hill, said County and State, known as the Tom Lowden house, together with all out-buildings thereunto appurtenant or in any wise belonging, and all their right, title and interest in and to the surface ground whereon the same is situate, and for which buildings has been heretofore used and appropriated.
