This Deed, made on November 26<sup>th</sup> 1907, by Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation, (by Wm. Swiger, Jr. its Attorney in Fact) first party, unto Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, second party, witnesseth: That in consideration of Ten (10) Dollars paid, receipt whereof is acknowledged, first party hereby quit-claims and conveys unto second party, and its successors and assigns, the North East quarter of North West quarter (N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-six (36), in Township Thirty-two (32) North, Range Fifty-one (51) East, Mount Diablo Meridian, containing Forty (40) Acres in the State of Nevada; which land was selected by, and by United States patent dated August 31<sup>st</sup> 1906 granted unto, the said Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company, in lieu of Lot number six (No. 6) of Section Thirty-one (31), in Township Twenty-two (22) North, Range Five (5) East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, containing Thirty-three and twenty-hundredths (33.20) Acres in Arizona.
