Easton, of the town of Austin, County of Lander, State of Nevada, the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, sell unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, the following goods and chattles, in the town of Beowawe, County of Eureka, State of Nevada, to-wit: One black horse branded  $\equiv$  on left hip. One bay horse branded on left hip, brand vented, "Starrett Brand." <sup>One Express wagon.</sup> And I do for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, covenant and agree, to and with the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, to warrant and defend the sale of the said property, goods and chattels, unto the said party of the second part and his executors, administrators and assigns, against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
