Western Pacific Railway Co. || Deed 127- F.

This Indenture made this 27th day of November 1908, by and between Central Pacific Railway Company, a corporation of the State of Utah, the party of the first part, United States Trust Company of New York, a corporation of the State of New York, as Trustee under a certain mortgage or deed of trust from said Central Pacific Railway Company, dated August 1st, 1899, the party of the second part, and Western Pacific Railway Company, a corporation of the State of California, the party of the third part, Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00), the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part hereby grants and conveys unto the party of the third part, its successors and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest which the party of the first part now has or may hereafter acquire from the United States in or to that certain irregular strip or tract of land, in the County of Esmeralda, State of Nevada, extending across the South half of Section 9, Township 31 North, Range 51 East, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian and bounded and described as follows: Bounded on the West by the west line of said Section 9; bounded on the East by the east line of said Section 9; bounded on the North by the south line of the 200 foot right of way of the party of the third part; and bounded on the South by the north line of the 400 foot right of way of the party of the first part; said strip or tract of land hereby conveyed containing 19.74 acres. Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof. To Have And To Hold

all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the third part, its successors and assigns forever. And the party of the second part, as Trustee as aforesaid, (the sale evidenced by this conveyance having been reported to it by the President or Vice-President and the Treasurer of the party of the first part, with full particulars as to the price and terms of such sale), hereby grants, releases and reconveys unto the party of the third part, its successors and assigns, all of the estate and interest derived to the party of the second part, as such Trustee, by or through said mortgage or deed of trust of August 1st. 1899, in or to the said strip or tract of land hereinbefore particularly described and hereby conveyed, and releases said strip or tract of land, together with all the rights, privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, from the lien of said mortgage or deed of trust of August 1st. 1899. To Have and To Hold the same, without any warranty whatsoever, unto the party of the third part, its successors and assigns forever. In Witness Whereof the party of the first part and the party of the second part, as such Trustee, have each, by its officers thereunto duly authorized, hereunto signed its corporate name and affixed its corporate seal, the day and year first above written.
