acknowledged, do by these presents, sell unto the party  
of the part and to his heirs, executors, administrators and  
assigns the following described personal property; one

branded thus T on the left side, also thirty (30) head  
of horses, more or less, branded thus I on the left shoulder,  
also any and all horses that may be found on the  
range in Pine Valley or thereabouts, branded thus T S being  
the old Williams horses, together with the above described  
brands and irons. It being the intention of the said  
parties of the first part to sell, and by these presents they  
do sell unto the said party of the second part all  
of the horses and cattle they now own or claim or have  
an interest in branded as aforesaid, together with the  
irons; also the farming tools, implements and machinery of  
every name, nature kind and description now upon those  
certain premises, situate in Pine Valley, County of Eureka,
