Substake Contract and Prospecting Agreement

To
Patrick Clark

In consideration of the covenants hereinafter contained, it is mutually agreed by and between J. Bresnahan, Dan Bresnahan, Thomas Kearns and John Howard of Nevada, parties of the first part and Patrick Clark of Spokane, Washington, party of the second part, Witnesseth: The parties of the first part agree to diligently and in good faith to prospect for, discover and locate within the Counties of Eureka and Lander, in the State of Nevada for the period of Three (3) months from this date mining claims, mill sites, town sites and water rights using their and each of their best endeavors as "prospectors" to find and locate profitable mining claims, mill sites, town sites and water rights.

In consideration of the foregoing promises and agreements made by the parties of the first part, the party of the second part agrees to furnish and pay all costs and expenses for the prospecting for and locating of mining claims, mill sites, town sites and water

rights within said two Counties, to include grub, mining tools, wagon or wagons, teams, harnesses, and such other necessary equipment and outfit as is suitable, convenient and profitable for the prospecting for and locating as aforesaid. And it is further agreed that the interest in any and all of said claims, sites or rights located during the life of this agreement shall belong to the parties of the first part and to the party of the second part jointly in the proportion of an undivided one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) to the parties of the first part and an undivided one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) to the party of the second part. And it is further mutually agreed between the respective parties hereto, that if the said second party deems it advisable to incorporate a Development Company with a capital stock of 1,500,000 shares, of which shares 500,000 shall be placed in the treasury of said company, the parties of the first part agree and bind themselves, jointly and severally, to well and truly convey all of the interest they or either of them may have or acquire in any mining claim or claims, mill site or sites, town site or sites or water right or rights, during the life of this agreement, to said company.
