Kelcey, Deceased, jointly and severally, to faithfully discharge its duties as such Trustee to the best of its ability and in the interests of the beneficiaries aforesaid, and to render due account to them upon request, at all reasonable times, of the property, moneys and effects which may or shall come into its possession in such trust capacity and the disposition thereof, and in the event of a sale or other disposition of the Trust Estate or any portion thereof, there shall come into its hands proceeds therefrom over and above the costs and expenses of executing said trust, to promptly pay over the same to such beneficiaries respectively in the proportions fixed by said Decree.
