

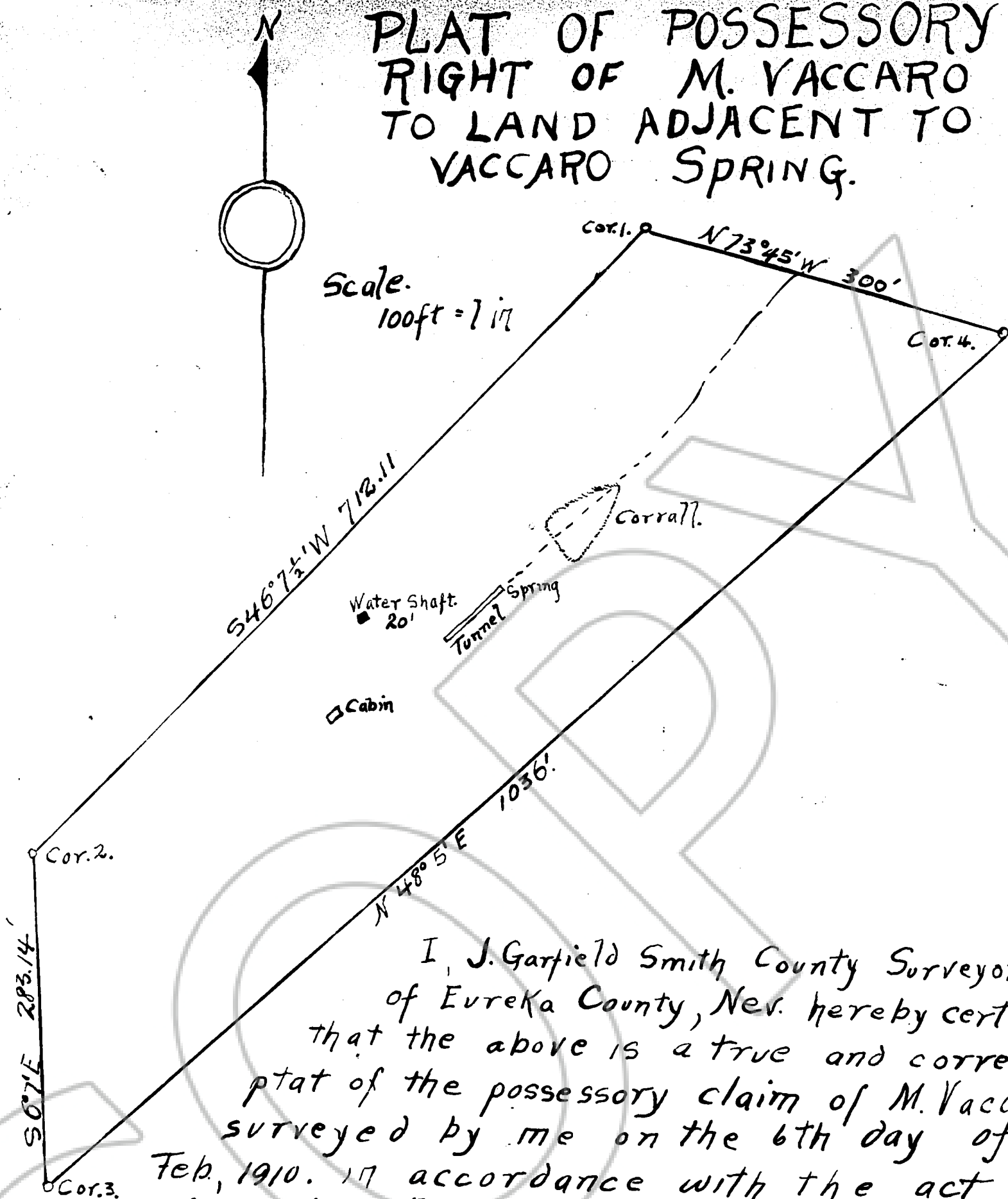
Vaccaro Claim by M. Vaccaro.

acres in Eureka County, State of Nevada, in accordance with
the Act of Legislature State of Nevada approved Mar. 9th 1865
entitled 'an act prescribing the mode of maintaining possessory
actions on public lands of this state', the said lands
being situated in Secret Canon about 2 miles south of the
Diamond Mine at Prospect in T 18 N. R. 5-3 E. M. D. M. (unsectioned)
Post 4' sq by 4 1/2' long, were set at each corner inscribed
P.C. - A-10 with the number of the corner containing
4.7 acres more or less. That he has taken no other
claim under this act and to best of his knowledge and
belief said lands are not claimed under any existing
title.
