

Dedication

Know all men by these presents, that we, Edward Herper (or Harper) and Theodore Plyme owners of a tract of land as platted and shown herein, the same being described as the Herper and Plyme Addition to Buckhorn, County of Eureka State of Nevada, have caused the surface of said tract of land to be sub-divided and platted into Lots, Blocks, Streets, Lanes and Alleys as shown hereon, do hereby dedicate to the Public an irrevocable permission to use the surface so shown as Streets, Lanes and Alleys until U.S. Patent therefor has been issued to them, their heirs or assigns; and thereupon and thereafter, reserving all veins, lodes, ledges, ores and minerals and the right to mine for and remove the same, do hereby dedicate the surface so platted into Streets, Lanes and Alleys to the public forever for use as Streets, Lanes and Alleys.

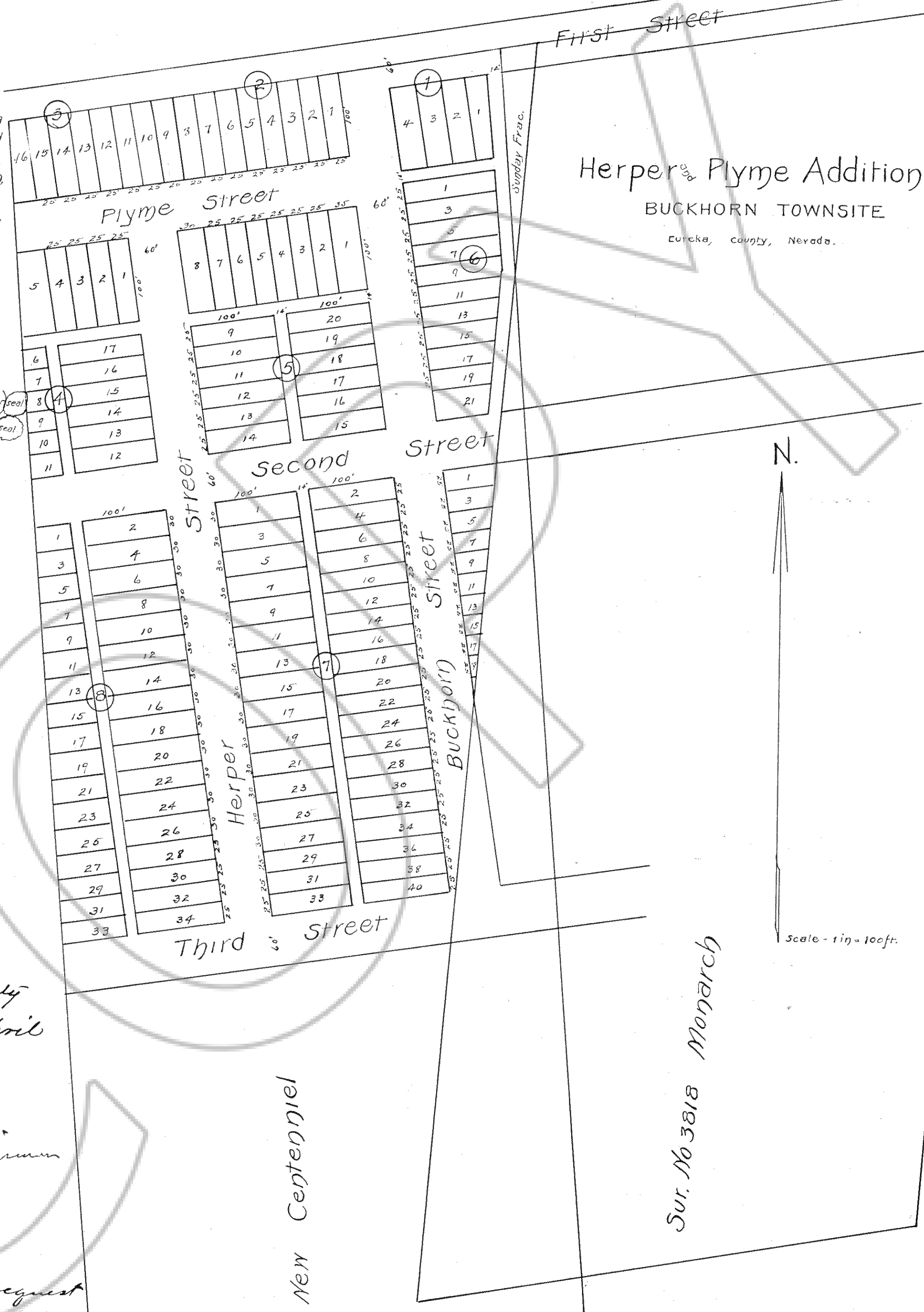
