

Bemane, Nevada, March 10, 1910.

Received from Dan. P. Murphy the sum of one dollar (\$^{1.00}) the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged for the following described mineral ground, situated in the Buckhorn Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada, and located, recorded, and known as the Lame Bull No. 1, Lame Bull No. 2 and Red Ant Lode Mining Claims. The entire price to be paid for the above described ground is Fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) and to be paid as follows: Two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) on or before the tenth day of September, 1910, and a further payment of Five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) on or before the tenth day of March, 1911, and a further payment of Eight thousand dollars (\$8,000.00) on or before the tenth day of September, 1911. All of the above payments to be placed to the credit of W. J. Mahoney and John White, in the Henderson Bank at Elko. Dan P. Murphy further agrees to perform not less than sixty shifts per month on said ground until the first payment is made. It is further agreed and understood, that the said W. J. Mahoney and John White will make a good and sufficient mining deed, conveying said mining property to Dan. P. Murphy and place said deed in escrow, in the Henderson Bank at Elko, on or before ninety days from date. In the failure of said Dan P. Murphy to fulfill any and all parts of this agreement - then this contract shall become null and void, and of no effect.
