

"Pinto Spring Mill site" ||

We the undersigned this 22nd day of May 1910;
Chas. O'Neil, T. A. Burdick, A. W. Clayton locate
five acres of land containing the Pinto spring as a
mill site for a group of ten claims known as the
Pinto group of 5 claims and Iron group of 5
claims. We claim 300 ft S.W. and 420 ft N.E. and
150 ft on each side of permanent monument. This claim
is marked by rock monuments and stakes at each
corner side centres and end centres. Located in Keystone
Range about a mile N.W. of Indian Ranch and
about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile N.W. of Demali meadow, in Canyon
between two mountains.
