Know all men by these presents That The Elko County Telephone and Telegraph Company a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Nevada, the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Sixteen Hundred (1600) Dollars lawful money of the

United States of America, to it in hand paid by Beowawe Mercantile Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Nevada, the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns that certain telephone line from the Town of Beowawe, in the County of Elko, State of Nevada, to Tenabo and Lander, passing partly through the County of Lander, consisting of all telephone wires, poles, insulators, and receivers, and all other personal property used in connection therewith. It being the intention of the party of the first part to convey, and it does hereby convey all of the appliances and appurtenances connected with said line in both Tenabo and Beowawe, and Lander in Lander County owned by said party of the first part. To have and to hold the same unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever. And the first party does for its successors and assigns covenant and agree, to and with the said party of the second part its successors and assigns to warrant and defend the sale of the said property, goods and chattels hereby made unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
