Spencer Reynolds Receiver of the Euclid County Bank

Know all men by these presents, that I, Wm J Dawe of the Town of Elko County of Elko, State of Nevada, in consideration of the execution of a certain deed by Spencer Reynolds, Receiver of the Eureka County Bank at Eureka, County of Eureka State of Nevada, conveying to the First National Bank of Elko, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the United States and having its place of business at Elko, Nevada, the following described lot of land in the town of Elko, County of Elko, State of Nevada, to-wit: - Commencing at the South West corner of Lot 18 in Block "D" as shown on the official map of said town, and running thence Northeasterly along the North west line of Railroad Street, fifteen feet, thence at right angles North westerly seventy five feet, more or less to an alley, thence at right angles Southwesterly fifteen feet, thence Southeasterly to the place of beginning: said tract being the southwesterly part of said lot and intended to include the part bounded as above lying between said Railroad Street and

said alley, which said deed has been duly executed by said Spencer Reynolds and duly delivered to The First National Bank of Elko, do by these presents, for myself my heirs, executors and administrators, remise release and forever discharge the said Spencer Reynolds as such Receiver and The Eureka County Bank from all liability to deed said land to me as provided in that certain agreement made and executed on the 24th day of November, 1906 wherein the Eureka County Bank agreed to convey said land to me upon the payment to it of the sum of \$3,750.00 and said contract is hereby annulled and forever discharged.
