Know all men By these presents, that we J. W. Esart and H. T. Esart, of Palisade, Ceweka County, state of Nevada, do hereby grant permission and right of way to Ceweka County, Nevada and its Board of County Commissioners, for all time to build, construct and maintain a lane or public highway, twenty five feet wide across and through our ranch at Palisade Ceweka County, Nevada, said lane to commence at the intersection of the Palisade to Ceweka Road, about opposite H. T. Esart's ranch, known as station # 10, passing up and around the Esart corral to connect with the present line fence, running southwest and northeast to station # 34 25, on the following conditions, to-wit: that the said Ceweka County and its Board of Commissioners shall construct and maintain and keep in good condition a fence 3200 long, a four strand barb wire fence, post five feet above the ground, sixteen feet between posts, said fence to run southwesterly from station 325 to station 34 25, according to specifications for the

construction of the road on file with the County Clerk of Cowie County, which are hereby made a part of this agreement, also to build and maintain and keep in good condition one gate, sixteen foot wide, to be placed where J. W. Esbert or H. T. Esbert may request, in the said fence built and maintained by the County, also to build a gate sixteen foot wide at station # 3425 at the west end of the lane.
