You are hereby notified that I have expended during the year 1910 three hundred dollars in labor and improvements upon the Comromise No. 5, Comromise No. 4 and Comromise No. 3, mining claims situate on Comromise Mountain in Dym Mining District, County of Eureka State of Nevada, the location certificate of which is found of record in Book one in the office of District recorder and in office of Recorder at Eureka, Eureka County, in order to hold said claims under the provisions of section 2324 of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the amendment thereto approved January 22, 1880, concerning annual labor upon mining claims, being the amount required to hold said lode for the period ending on the 31st day of December, 1910, a. d. and if, within ninety days after the publication thereof you fail or refuse to contribute your proportion of such expenditure as a co-owner, which amounts to one hundred and fifty (\$150.00) dollars, your interest in the claims will become the property of the
