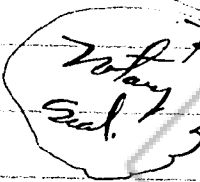
dollars (# 83.331-8) your interest in the claims will become the property of the subscriber who has made the required expenditure, by the terms of said section.

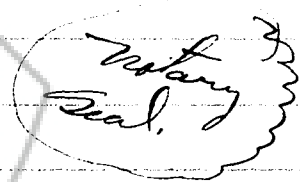
