expended during the year 1910 over three hundred dollars (\$300) in labor and improvements upon the sold # group of claims, said group consisting of the claims named as follows: sold # no. 2. sold # no. 3 and Esalzgrader no. 4. The said work being done for the group upon the sold # no. 2. in a vertical shaft sinking 12 feet farther and connecting by ¹³ ~~an~~ tunnel to old workings, and an open cut about 30 feet long and south of said shaft.
