All our right, title and interest in the property, stock of goods, and good will of the merchandise business, known as the "Post Office Store", in the Town of Buckhorn, County of Eureka, State of Nevada.

All our right, title and interest in the Water System, known as the "Pipe Line". Also all our right, title and interest in the Electric System, known as "The Pole Line", all in the Town of Buckhorn, County of Eureka, State of Nevada.

And we do for our heirs, executors and administrators, covenant and agree, to and with the parties of the second part, and with their executors, administrators and assigns, to warrant and defend the sale of the said property, goods and chattels, unto the parties of the second part, their executors, administrators and assigns, against all and every person and persons, whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.

And it is further agreed that the said parties of the first part will not engage, or invest

or cause to be invested in any mercantile business in the Town of Buckhorn, County of Eureka, State of Nevada, for the term of five (5) years from date hereof.
