Williams, of Eureka County, Nevada, the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, sell unto the said party of the second part his executors, administrators, heirs and assigns and undivided one-half (1/2) interest in and to the following personal property, to-wit:

An undivided one-half interest in and to Eight (8) head of Stock Cattle, branded (IHB) (I H B) on Left Hip, and Ear Marked with two slits in the Left Ear, and all their increase, said Cattle now being at the Williams Ranch in Eureka County, Nevada.

And said party of the first part does for his heirs, executors and assigns, covenant and agree, to and with the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, to warrant and defend the sale of the said property, goods and chattels, unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
