Right-of-way, near the J.E. Sexton House, together with all and singular the fixtures and furniture therein contained, also one sewing Machine.

And I do for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part, her executors, administrators, and assigns, to warrant and defend the sale of said property, goods, and chattels hereby made unto the said party of the second part, her executors, administrators, and assigns, against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
