I, ELISHA C.MOWRY, of the City and County of Providence in the State of Rhode Island, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to me paid by the ONONDAGO MINES CORPORATION, a Corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of Nevada, and of other valuable considerations, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby assign, transfer and set over unto the said Onondago Mines Corporation, its successors and assigns, all my right, title and interest in and to that certain agreement of bond and lease bearing date of January 1st, 1918, where in the Elko Lumber Company as party of the first part, bonded and leased to Elisha C.Mowry as party of the second part, those certain mining claims situate in the Safford Mining District, Eureka County State of Nevada, known as the ZEMOLI, the WHITE ROOSTER, the GREEN MOUNTAIN and RED MOUNTAIN EXTENSION and the ST.PATRICK, together with all the buildings and improvements, and all privileges appertaining thereto; which said agreement of bond and lease is recorded in the records of Eureka County, Nevada, in Liber D of Miscellaneous, Page 30.
