

NOTICE OF BEGINNING OF ABSENCE FROM SETTLEMENT CLAIM.

Sirs:

I, Alma J. Woods, of Eureka, Nevada have in good faith made settlement upon and improved a tract of unsurveyed, unreserved, unappropriated public land of the United States supposed to contain about 320 acres, with the intention of entering same under the homestead laws after it shall have been surveyed, and I have plainly marked on the ground the exterior boundaries of the land claimed by me.

Its approximate location is as follows; Sections 8 and 17 Township 18 N. Range 49E. M.D.M. N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$. SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$. NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$. NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$. SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8 and North $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17. Approximately.

Having lived on the land since a date not later than the May 15th. 1918 day of May, in the year 1918, I count my residence years as beginning on that calendar day.

I hereby give notice that I intend to be absent from said land for a period not exceeding five months, beginning Dec. 15th. 1918. Upon my return to the land I will notify you to that effect.
