- - JUDGEMENT AND DECREE\* -

This action coming on regularly for trial, the plaintiffs appearing by their attorneys

Messrs. TOBIN & TOBIN and MORLEY GRISWOLD, and no one appearing for any of the defendants it was

proved to the Court that the summons was duly served upon each of the defendants, and that the

time within which they were allowed to appear and answer has expired and that none of the defendants have appeared or answered; evidence having been introduced proving the truth of all of the allegations in the complaint contained and the cause being submitted for decision.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED That the plaintiffs have and take the releif asked for in the complaint; that the plaintiff JENNIE C.DUNPHY MEYER, Trustee under the Will of William Dunphy, deceased, is hereby authorized and directed to borrow the sum of One Humdred Thousand (\$100,000.00) Dollars lawful monwy of the United States, and to execute and deliver to the lender or lenders a promissory note or notes for the said sum of money payable three years after date with interest at a rate not exceeding seven (7) percent per annum, and to execute and deliver to the lender or lenders of said sum of money a mortgage or mortgages securing the payment of such promissory note or notes, said mortgage or mortgages to contain a provision for the payment of reasonable counsel fees and all other provisions customery in mortgages, mortgaging to the lender or lenders of said sum of money all the land and real estate described in the complaint on file herein as having been set apart in partition to the plaintiff JENNIE C.DUNEHY MAYER, Trustee, by judgment and decree of partition entered on the lefth day of August, 1916, in an action entitled "JennieC.D.Meyer, et al, vs Viola Carrie Carmen Piercy Burnett, et al," in the District Court of the Fourth Judicial District of the State of Meyeds, in and for the County of Elko, together with the cettle upon said land, or mortgaging either the land or cettle separately.

The following is a description of the lands which the plaintiff Jennie C.Dunphy Mayer, Trustee. is authorized to mortgage:

Those certain parcels of land and those certain water rights described and set apart to the said Jennie C.Dunphy Meyer, Trustee under the Will of William Dunphy, deceased, by the terms of tinal judgment and decree in an action entitled "Jennie C.Dunphy Meyer, Trustee, vs Viola Carrie Carmen Piercy Burnett," in the District Court of the Fourth Judicial District of the State of Nevada, County of Elko, entered August 16th, 1916, together with the cattle on said lands.
