To have and to hold the same to the said party of the second part, her executors, administrators, and assigns forever. And I do for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part, her executors, administrators, and assigns to warrant and defend the sale of the said property, goods and chattels hereby made unto the said party of the second part, her executors, administrators, and assigns, against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
