ORDER OF ADOPTION.

It being shown to this Court, in the above-entitled matter, that Fred Bartine, and Lena Bartine, his wife, on the 17th day of November, 1923, filed a petition in said Court for leave to adopt JANE DOE, a minor child of the approximate age of nine weeks; that consent to such adoption is not necessary under the Statute of Nevada, for the reason that said child was abandoned on or about the 18th day of October, 1923, in the town of Eureka, County of Eureka, State of Nevada, and that the parents of said child are unknown, and that the whereabouts of the parents of said child cannot be ascertained; that at the time said child was abandoned it was left in the Eureka Hotel, Eureka, Nevada, and ever since said abandonment has been in the care and custody of Edward Herrera, and Kate Herrera, his wife; that the said Edward Herrera and Kate Herrera, his wife have appeared before this Court, and have given their consent to the adoption of said child by the said Fred Bartine, and Lena Bartine, his wife; and the said matter now coming regularly on for hearing, the Court proceeds to an examination of the case, and find that said petitioners, and all persons whose consent is necessary, have each appeared herein, and were examined as provided by law; that each of said petitioners resides in this County and that the interests of JANE DOE, the said minor child, will be promoted by such adoption:

It is therefore ordered, adjudged, and decreed that the said petitioners, Fred Bartine, and Lena Bartine, his wife, adopt said minor child; that henceforth the said minor child shall be treated by them in all respects as their own lawful child should be treated, including the right of inheritance; and that said petitioners and the said minor child shall hereafter bear towards each other the relation of parent and child.
