TERMS Foregoing deferred payments shall bear interest at the rate of \_\_\_\_\_% per annum from date of invoice until paid. Interest on balances to be paid with each installment when due. Interest at 8% on delinquent payments.

TITLE THIS PROPOSAL IS MADE UPON THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:  
 That the title and ownership of the property herein specified shall remain in this Company until final payment therefor has been made in full as above provided.  
 You shall take all such legal steps as may be required by <sup>the</sup> laws of your state for the preservation of this Company's title as herein provided, and in the event of default by you in making any of said payments when due as above provided, the full amount of the purchase price shall, at the election of this Company, become immediately due and payable, in which event this Company, or its agents or representatives, shall have the right to take possession of said property, wherever found, without process of law, and shall not be held liable for such seizure. The said property shall be and remain strictly personal property and retain its character as such, no matter whether on permanent foundation or in what manner affixed or attached to building or structure, or what may be the consequences of its being disturbed on such foundation, building or structure, or for what purpose the property may be used. The Purchaser hereby expressly agrees that he will not rent or permit the equipment herein mentioned to be rented during the existence of this agreement.

That the receipt of the property when delivered to you, or to your agents, shall constitute a waiver of all claims for damages by reason of any delay, and that you will make good to us any loss or damage to said property caused by fire or otherwise, from the time of delivery to you, as herein stated, until the said property is fully paid for as provided herein.

It is expressly understood this proposal, made in duplicate, contains all agreements pertaining to property herein specified, there being no verbal understanding whatsoever, and when signed by Purchaser and approved by an Executive Officer or District Manager of The Denver Rock Drill Mfg. Co., becomes a contract binding parties hereto.

All items of this proposal are contingent upon and subject to strikes, accidents or other causes beyond our control.
