THIS INDENTURE, made this 5th day of November, 1926, between SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY, a corporation, party of the first part, and CENTRAL PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, party of the second part, WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, the party of the second part has heretofore acquired the premises hereinafter described, causing the legal title thereto to be transferred to said party of the first part, and said party of the second part has requested said party of the first part to execute a conveyance of said premises to it, the said party of the second part.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the sum of Ten (10) Dollars, law-ful money of the United States of America, to it paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, party of the first part does by these presents grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to its successors and assigns forever, all of its right, title and interest in and to those certain lots, pieces or parcels of land situate, lying and being in the County of Eureka, State of Nevada, and bounded and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

## PARCEL 1.

Beginning at a point in the north line of Section 2, Township 31 North, Range 51 East, M.D.M., said point being distant 100.0 feet measured at a right angle easterly from the center line of the Central Pacific Railway Company's present constructed railroad; thence Southerly, parallel with said center line and distant 100.0 feet easterly therefrom, a distance of 65.0 feet, more or less, to an intersection with the easterly line of the original 400 foot right of way of the Central Pacific Railway; thence northwesterly along the easterly line of said original 400 foot right of way, a distance of 65.0 feet, more or less, to an intersection with the north line of said Section 2; thence easterly along said north line, a distance of 35.0 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, as conveyed by deed dated April 5, 1906, from T.
