BILL OF SALE

THIS BILL OF SALE, made and entered into as of the 31st day of December, 1927, by and between BEOVAWE MERCANTILE COMPANY, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Nevada and having its principal place of business at Beowawe, Eureka County, Nevada, party of the first part, and F. E. LEONARD, TRUSTEE, of the County of Eureka, State of Nevada, party of the second part,

W I T N E S S E T H:

That for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Sixty (\$160.00) Dollars by the said second party to the said first party in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said party of the first part does by these presents, sell, assign, transfer, set over, and deliver unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, all that certain personal property particularly described as follows: to-wit:

A certain frame building known as the "HESSON BUIDLING", together with a certain frame garage buidling and chicken house, situate at Beowawe, Eureka County, Nevada, on a certain lot lying Easterly and across the street from the lots on which are situate the Hotel, Store and Saloon Buildings this day conveyed by the first party to the second party herein; also a certain telephone line running from Beowawe, Eureka County, Nevada, to Tenabo, Lander County, Nevada;

The said total consideration of \$160.00 above expressed being \$150.00 for the said Hesson Buidling and garage and chicken house, and the sum of \$10.00 for the said telephone line.
